School Uniform Information

Parent Council are currently reviewing school uniform at the moment but I stress that the school uniform has not been changed. There seems to be some confusion about colour of tights permitted; tights should be red or green. I therefore ask that for the remainder of this half term, as you replace tights, they are in the specified colours and that from January, it is expected that all girls will be dressed in the correct colour tights.

Parents are also reminded that children are not allowed to wear nail vanish or jewellery (other than a watch and a pair of stud earrings) to school. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
