Careful Parking - URGENT REMINDER

I have written to you several times this year regarding parking outside school and unfortunately I do so again. A local resident has written to me complaining how parents have parked across his drive blocking him in whilst they are dropping off and/or collecting. He also complained that he was spoken to in an aggressive manner when he challenged drivers about their parking. The PTA has recently provided cones to deter drivers from pulling up in a no stopping zone. We want all our children to follow laws and treat people with respect and it is very unfortunate if they are witnessing these disputes. The local police have been notified about this on-going situation. As I wrote about previously, we had a very close near miss a couple of weeks ago and I worry that there will be a serious accident if drivers do not demonstrate more care. It is also important that we enjoy positive relationships with our neighbours so again I plead with you to park, as I am sure that many of our parents always do, responsibly and legally, even if it means a slightly longer walk to school. I ask for your full support in this matter.

Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Did you know...? Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.
