# Collecting Children at the end of the school day

Holy Cross is committed to safeguarding children and therefore parents are reminded that only people who are on a child's data sheet can collect children from the class teacher.

There is a growing number of occasions when parents are sending other parents to collect their children whilst they wait out in the road/in the car. Children will be kept beside their class teachers until the named person comes inside the school gates to collect them. Children are not allowed to walk out of the school unsupervised unless we have prior written consent. I thank you for your cooperation in this very important matter.


# Swimming Gala

Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Did you know...? Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.
