

England Lionesses

We have been offered a fantastic opportunity to inspire girls' sport by taking the girls' football team to watch the England Women's' football team train at St. George's Park Football Centre on *Tuesday 21 November 2017*. The girls will be able to watch them in a training session before their upcoming World Cup qualifier against Bosnia and Herzegovina. After the training session the girls will get the chance to meet the team, have a photo and hopefully get some autographs.



We have also been given the chance to purchase cheaper tickets to watch the England Lionesses play in their next 2019 Fifa Women's World Cup Qualifier on *Friday 24 November* at the Banks's Stadium, Walsall Football Club. The match is against Bosnia & Herzegovina and kick off is 7.05pm.

In partnership with the FA, we can offer the tickets at £7.50 for an adult £1 for concessions (this includes children under the age of 18 and adults over 60). This is a fantastic offer to watch the national team and a great experience of international football. The Lionesses are currently in great form and it promises to be an excellent match.

Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.

Each week we will be recognising those children who we feel have made that extra special effort and show the virtues in their daily life.


