KS2 Lunchtime arrangements from Monday 13 April 2015

From the Summer term, KS2 lunchtime will increase by 10 minutes to 55 minutes rather than the current 45 minutes. In line with other schools, there will no longer be an afternoon break (15 mins). This change will enable us to have time to organise learning for children more effectively and for children to participate in wider activities at lunchtime. This will also enable more effective use of Teaching Assistant time to support learning. Thank you for your cooperation.

Change to time of the end of school day.

We are proposing to change the time of the end of the school day from 3.30pm to 3.20pm from the Summer term 2015. The purpose is to ensure time is used productively to ensure the best outcomes for children. This change is as a result of a more productive use of time at the start of the day and the removal of afternoon break for KS2. This change will enable us to use time more effectively and be more in line with our Academy Schools and our other local Primary Schools.

The reasons for these proposals are:

- 1. To support the national and wider curriculum more effectively the changes will enable us to have time to organise learning for children more effectively.
- 2. The new curriculum has an emphasis on creative learning and transfer of skills. As Holy Cross has already developed this approach, there is not the need to always teach individual subjects in discrete lessons which previously overloaded the timetable. With the removal of afternoon break (KS2) and shortened break for KS1, there will be a productive and uninterrupted two hour long quality teaching and learning opportunity.
- 3. More effective use of Teaching Assistants' time to support learning.
- 4. Taking into account movement time at either side of break and time already saved by the more efficient start to the school day, in practical terms there will be no loss of teaching time.
- 5. To coincide the end of the day timings for parents with children attending Holy Cross Pre School

Nursery.

Please note there will be no increase in Kids' Club charges due to earlier end to school day.

These changes will enable Holy Cross Catholic Primary School's hours to be in line with the Academy and neighbouring schools.

We welcome any feedback on this proposal. Please send any comments you have regarding this matter to the school office before the end of February and they will be considered before a final decision is made.
