#### **Family Placements**

- Fostering and Adoption Support services.
- Origins service helping those who are now seeking information about their origins.

#### **Adult Care Services**

- St Joseph's home for frail older people and those with dementia.
- St Catherine's bungalows for adults with multiple disabilities and complex needs.
- Domiciliary Care for adults with mild to moderate learning disabilities.
- Coleshill Day Services for adults with multiple disabilities.

### **Community Projects**

- Schools Family Support Project working with schools to help vulnerable children and their families, in Stoke-on-Trent, Birmingham, Coventry and Oxfordshire.
- Anawim supporting vulnerable women in Birmingham.
- Hope Family Project seeking out and supporting vulnerable families and the wider community in Wolverhampton.
- Brushstrokes working with the hidden poor in Smethwick.
- Parish projects supporting parishes as they develop their own local, projects.
