Eastside City Park

Eastside City Park is situated on Curzon Street, Birmingham B4 7XG. It is opposite the south entrance to Millennium Point. The entrance to the Fanzone is via Fazeley Street.

By Car

There is a multi-storey car park owned and managed by Birmingham City Council situated adjacent to Millennium Point. The car park can be accessed via Jennens Road. If using sat nav please use the following postcode – B4 7AP. The multi-storey car park has a height restriction of 2.1m (6'10").

Please note – The Birmingham City Council multi-storey car park accepts cash or card payments. An HSBC cash point is situated on Level O within Millennium Point,

Bu Rail

The nearest train station is Moor Street Station (10 mins walk away) and then New Street Station (15 mins walk away). Snow Hill Station is also close by (15 mins walk away).

By Foot

Eastside City Park is less than a 10 minute walk from Moor Street Station.

- From Moor Street Station, walk away from the Bullring, along Moor Street Queensway.
- At Fazeley Street turn right, Hotel La Tour will be on your left.
 The entrance to the Fanzone is via Fazeley Street.
