No throat sweets to be sent in with children

Obviously the change of weather has led to an increase of colds and coughs. This week, several children have brought throat sweets into school. This is a reminder that for health and safety reasons, cough/throat sweets are not to be sent in to school with children. I have taken advice from the School Nurse who fully supports the school's stance on this matter. Any type of non-prescribed medication is not allowed. These sweets have clear restrictions about how many should be consumed in a day. The school cannot monitor this safely and cannot be confident that sweets are not being shared by children and/or that children are not exceeding the advised quantity. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Did you know...? Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.
