Children Centres Consultation

Please see message from Sue Bailey, Children's Centre Lead for Sutton Coldfield.

You may or not be aware that on the 9th of June Birmingham City Council announced that the contract for the new Early Years Health and Well Being Service had been awarded to Birmingham Community Health Care NHS Trust Foundation in partnership with Barbados, Spurgeons Children's Charity, St Pauls Community Development Trust and The Springfield Project.

The way that we deliver children centres, health visiting services and parenting support services in Birmingham is changing.

In relation to Sutton Coldfield the proposal is that the following venues will be closed or re utilised. The Deanery Children's Centre

Four Oaks Children's Centre - including the services offered at The Hub in Mere Green and the Toy Library Bush Babies Children's Centre.

New Hall Children's Centre would be open all year round and Holland House Children's Centre would offer sessional activities. There would also be a range of other venues across Sutton where activities could be delivered. It is important to note the impact on baby clinics, antenatal classes and post natal. Some areas of Sutton would have limited access to services.

June 19th 2017 saw the start of an important public consultation giving members of the public and in particular service users , with an under 5, the opportunity to have a say on these proposals to include delivery locations, which should stay open and which should close, and opening times.

There will also be a number of open forum events. These sessions are open to all and we would particularly welcome those families with an under five who use our services. These services provide an opportunity for members of the public to hear about the proposals and to ask questions

We are very disappointed that the open forum for Sutton Coldfield is during the school summer holidays. We know, as our parents have told us that this will impact upon attendance. We have asked for an alternative date but do not have this at the moment.

However we are holding our own event on Monday July 17th at 10 am at Mere Green Community Centre. We do hope as many of our local parents and council representatives will be able to join us.

We would encourage you to read the proposals, think about what services you want in Sutton, and where, and then complete the consultation. We feel that the proposals show quite clearly a lack of understanding of our community needs. We fully appreciate the need to have services located in our areas of most need but we are concerned about access due to limited public transport arrangements to some centres and an uneven distribution of services across Sutton. The proposals would see some long established and very successful services close and venues that have become very popular in terms of delivering health services no longer in use. We are also aware of some considerable budget cuts.

Following the end of the consultation period on August 19^{th} , your view will be considered and taken into account. Using your views a recommendation will be made to the BCC Cabinet in September on how services will be delivered.

In the meantime we will continue to deliver our services across Sutton Coldfield. However we would ask for your support to ensure that these services are not reduced and continue to meet the needs of families across our locality with an under 5. We look forward to seeing you on the 17^{th} . Did you know...? Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.
