School Meals

There are some changes at lunchtime this year as the Academy now have a contract with Caterlink to run our meals service. They have taken over from our previous providers, Citiserve who provided a traded service for Birmingham City Council for many years. There are no changes to staffing in the kitchen and Mrs Watts is still our cook but our providers have introduced an exciting new menu based on an increased use of fresh produce. We are confident that the children will enjoy the food on offer and get a healthy, balanced meal every day. Please see the attached menu and welcome note from Caterlink. Arrangements for paying for dinners via Parentpay remain the same as last year.

The menu is offers a variety of dishes all prepared from natural ingredients so I do ask you to be patient whilst the children become more familiar with the meals. I have tried the food myself and am very impressed not only by the quality but by the variety of fruit and vegetables that the children have been given the opportunity to try. The vast majority of children have been positive in their feedback which is very pleasing.

In order for parents to see at first hand the food Caterlink offers, a taster session will be held during this half term. I will notify you when we have a definite date. I ask you for your support in these early days.

Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Did you know...? Under new Government legislation, a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.




