Dietary Needs

Caterlink have extensive experience in catering for pupils that have specific dietary needs, ranging from gluten free diets, lactose / dairy intolerance and even textured diets for those with special requirements. Caterlink are a nut-free caterer and none of our products will contain any trace of nuts.

We will ask any relevant parents/carers to complete an allergy form where you can outline what special dietary needs your child may have. Once the form has been completed, parents/carers of children with any special diets/allergies will be contacted by the Caterlink Operations Manager. This allows the Operations Manager to gain a full understanding of the intolerance or diet required and put measures in place to allow us to cater for the child safely.

We understand dietary requirements can change, therefore we ask parents/carers to complete a form annually at the start of each new academic year to keep us up to date.
