Plastic Drinking Bottles

Children are to bring their own water bottles in every day; the school will no longer provide plastic drinking bottles for children. Please send your child with a drink of water in a transparent plastic non spill bottle (clearly labelled with child's name); cans or glass bottles are not allowed for safety reasons. Children are encouraged to drink water throughout the day and during PE lessons. Children can refill their bottles when needed. Please do not be alarmed if your child comes home with a full bottle of water it means that they have refilled it. Thank you.

Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.
