Head Lice


There have been quite a few outbreaks of head lice in school. We should be grateful if you would be vigilant and check your child's hair carefully. If you discover that your child does have evidence of head lice, we suggest that you shampoo and comb conditioner through your child's hair every other day for at least two weeks. If you require any further information regarding the appropriate form of treatment, contact a pharmacist for advice. Children with long hair must have it tied back and plaited for school.

Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.
