
# **England Lionesses**

The workshop will take place on Monday 4 December 2017 at 2.00pm until 3.15pm.



Please note that due to the ordering of food, late payments will not be accepted. If your child is in KS1 and normally has sandwiches you will need to order a child's meal but no payment is required due to the universal free school meal entitlement. This will be a non-school uniform day. Children can wear their Christmas jumpers on that day to get into the Christmas spirit. Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.
