- Staff will arrive at Church between 8.40am and 8.50am.
- Parents are expected to stay and supervise their children and ensure they behave appropriately until staff
 arrive and take over responsibility. For safeguarding reasons, children must not be dropped off and left
 at Church without an adult.

We are grateful for any additional adult volunteers who are prepared to walk back to school with the children.



Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.
