### Flowers and Ties

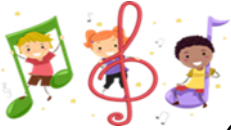

A letter has been emailed home. Please contact the school office if you require a paper copy.

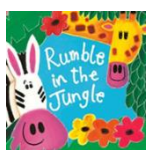

Please ensure you complete notes section; stating how many meals you have ordered. If your child has school meals every day, please pay for their meal in the normal way and just order the appropriate additional adult meal. If you are unable to attend on your allocated date; please contact the school office for an alternative day.

The deadline for ordering and paying for meals is **Tuesday 22 May**; **We do not want anyone to miss out but as food needs to be ordered in advance, no late orders can be accepted after this date.**

**Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.**

Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

**Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.**

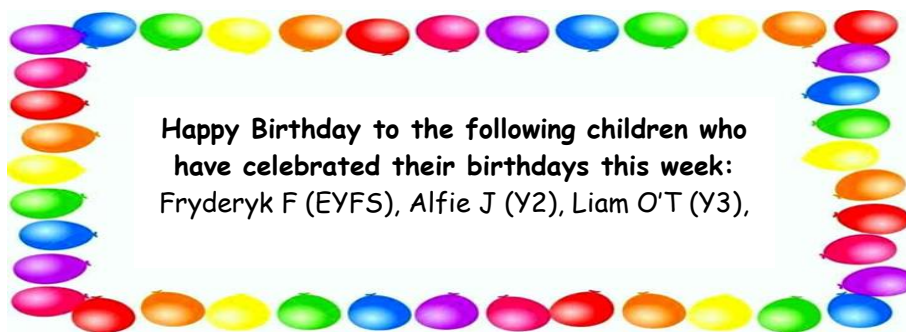
### Angel of the Week

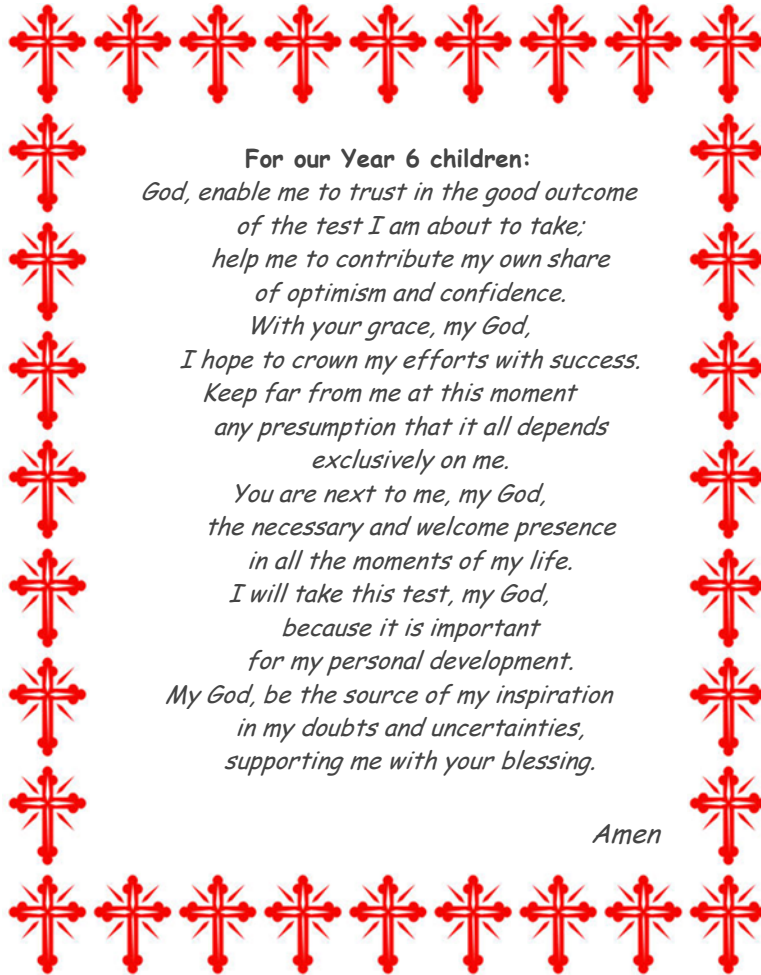
