This year, the Holy Father urges us to reach out to our brothers and sisters who are forced to flee their homes. This new campaign is called *Share the Journey*. To link with this a CAFOD Schools Volunteer will be visiting school to work with Key Stage 2 pupils on **Friday June 8**. As part of the preparation for these workshops your family may like to take part in a Share the Journey walk. You and your family can *Share the Journey* by joining Holy Cross Parish Walk on **Sunday June 3**. This is not just any walk; this is a walk around the world.

Schools, parishes, and local communities across England and Wales, including our own, will be walking to show solidarity with people on the move. Together, we are aiming for 24,900 miles – the distance around the whole world.

Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year.

Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.
