Refugee Week

This year our school will be taking part in the nationwide event 'Refugee Week', which aims to raise an awareness and celebration of the contribution of refugees to the UK.

The theme of Refugee Week 2019, <u>'You, me and those who came before</u>', is an invitation to explore the lives of refugees - and those who have welcomed them - throughout the generations.

During this week the Mini Vinnies and the Rights Respecting Representatives have chosen to collect donations for St Chad's Sanctuary which is in Birmingham and is a place of welcome for Refugees and Asylum Seekers. They desperately need donations of children's clothing, from the age of 4-12 years old. During this week please could you send in donations of children's clothing for our team to collect and drop off at St Chad's Sanctuary on Friday 21 June 2019.

We would also like to take this opportunity to invite any member of your family into the school On Monday 17 June at 9.00a.m, who may wish to share their experience of being a refugee or an immigrant with their child's class. It is important for our children to understand that Refugees and Asylum Seekers live within our community. Attendance - Our school strives for 100% attendance.

Government legislation states that a child with an attendance of 90% and below is categorised as a "Persistent Absence Pupil". An attendance figure of 90% equates to missing half a day every week that means four weeks of missed school work across the whole year. Parents should also be aware that referrals to the school nurse will be considered for those children with an attendance rate of below 95% due to health related absences.


